### **Course Outline:**

This course is the first part of a pair of courses with the following objectives:

- 1. To provide you with an opportunity to engage in sustained and intensive study of a topic by developing, writing, and presenting a research paper.
- 2. To apply empirical and theoretical skills that you have acquired and developed from core curriculum courses
- 3. To develop your research skills and written communication skills
- 4. Where possible (or if you are lucky enough), to produce original results.

A course calendar will be distributed on May 11.

Students are responsible for finding their own research topics, which must, however, be approved by the instructors. For some topics, supplementary supervision from faculty in the chosen subject area may be required. The instructors will offer some suggestions for students who are looking for a topic by May 1. Students should begin developing paper topics as soon as possible.

# There will be a preliminary meeting on Wednesday May 11 in room ST 055 at 9:30. All registered students are expected to attend this preliminary session.

### **Grade Determination and Final Examination Details:**

The final grade will be based on the elements and weights below:

Proposal	30%
Literature Review	35%
Data presentation and description	35%

Assignments are marked on a numerical (percentage) basis, and then converted to letter grades. The course grade is then calculated using the weights indicated above. As a guide to determining standing, the university letter grade equivalences will generally apply
