Course Outline:

This course is the second part of a pair of courses with the following objectives:

- To provide you with an opportunity to engage in sustained and intensive study of a topic by developing, writing, and presenting a research paper.
- To apply empirical and theoretical skills that you have acquired and developed from core curriculum courses
- To develop skills in research methods, written communication, and oral presentation.
- To produce original results that contribute to our understanding of economic phenomena.

A detailed course outline will be distributed in the first week of lectures.

The research topic will be a continuation of the topic developed in the Spring course. During this course, you will implement the methods you have described, discuss the results in a research paper, and prepare and give an oral presentation describing your results.

There will be two days of presentations, dates to be announced.

Grade Determination and Final Examination Details:

The final grade will be based on the elements and weights below:

Research paper 70% Oral presentation 30%

Assignments are marked on a numerical (percentage) basis, and then converted to letter grades. The course grade is then calculated using the weights indicated above. As a guide to determining standing, the university letter grade equivalences will generally apply
