Course Outline:

The student will participate in research on assigned topics in applied energy economics pertinent to the ongoing work of the Institute. Through this experience, the student will develop skills in research planning and design, data collection, analysis and communication of methods and results, and working on a team. Presentation skills will also be developed.

Grade Determination and Final Examination Details:

Students will be evaluated in terms of group projects with both oral and written presentations (6 projects, each worth one-sixth of final grade). Marks will be assessed in percentage terms and then converted to letter grades using the following

scale:
