RULES & REGULATIONS: ARTS

BA in Economics (ECON Major) or any other Major Field

- 1. Successful Completion of FORTY (40) one-term courses with:
 - (a) a minimum overall GPA of 2.0
 - (b) Not more than 6 one-term courses with D or D+ grades
 - (c) Not more than 2 one-term courses with D or D+ grades in the Major (e.g., ECON)
- 2. (a) Not more than 20 one-term courses can be transferred from other institutions
 - (b) A maximum of 8 one-term courses in eligible post-secondary transfer credits from other institutions may be counted toward the major
- 3. A minimum of 14 and maximum of 20 one-term courses in the major (e.g., ECON)
- 4. At least 2 one-term science courses from the Faculty of Science.

Note: Math 249 or 265, and STAT 205 or 213 count toward this total.

BA in Economics (ECON Major) or any other Major Field (Continued)

- 5. At least 24 one-term courses at the senior level (300-level or above).

 Note: This implies at most 16 one-term courses at the junior level (200-level) can count towards a degree.
- 6. A maximum of two one-term physical activity courses.

***Further Features:

BA Degrees are granted "with Distinction" to students achieving a GPA above 3.6 on the final 30 one-term courses counting toward their degrees.
